We are excited to announce that enrollment is now open for 3 courses in our 2-week study abroad program in Bulgaria: Biocultural Anthropological Approaches to Health & Healing, Modernization, and Ethnographic Methods.

Join us this June to learn ethnographic methods while immersed in Bulgarian healing practices and witnessing the process of modernization as it's happening. Bulgaria is a country that is undergoing tremendous cultural and political change as a former Soviet Bloc state and as one of the newer member states of the European Union. We will overnight in 6 exciting locations around the country including the cities of Sofia and Plovdiv, the village of Stolat in the Balkans, and ancient spa towns of Kyustendil and Hisarya. You will experience cities and rural spaces in transition, healing thermal spas, a 10th century monastery, the beauty of the Rila mountains, the role of cultural tourism in economic development, and spend time with seniors at the Elder Center of Stolat.

All courses are open to students from CSULB or other universities as well as to community members who are interested in learning about Bulgarian culture and history and ethnography. You get to choose which classes fit your interests and graduation needs: ANTH 353: Health & Healing, ANTH 307: Modernization in Global Perspective and ANTH 440: Ethnographic Field School. You can take 1 or 2 classes on the same trip.
